

Report on the Field Work
B.A. 4th Semester (Major & General Course)
Subject: Environmental Studies
Paper: 301(B)

Syllabus Guideline:

All students of B. A. 4th Semester, Major and General Courses are required to undertake a Field Work equal to 5 lecture hours for the Environmental Studies paper where they have to undertake some of the following activities-

- a) Visit a local area to document environmental assets such as river, forest grassland, hill etc.
- b) Visit to a local polluted site of an urban/rural/industrial/agricultural background.
- c) Study of common plants, insects and birds.
- d) Study of simple ecosystems of a pond, river and hill slopes etc.

The students are required to submit a Report based on their findings after visiting such a place. A total of 10 marks are allotted to that report for every student in his/her final assessment as per guidelines prescribed by Gauhati University.

a) Year 2015-2016

Title of the Project: A Study on the biodiversity of Deepar Beel (Lake).

Outcome: A Total of 210 students consisting of 17 Assamese Major, 1 Economics Major, 6 Education Major, 10 English Major, 5 Hindi Major, 5 Philosophy major, 11 Political Science Major and 155 General course students of the B.A. 4th Semester carried out the field visit to nearby Deepar Beel (Lake) under the guidance of teachers of different departments of the college. Students greatly enjoyed the 'outside the class learning' environment. Later they submitted detailed field study report highlighting environmental status, concerns of the lake after consulting the concerned teacher of the subject at the college.

b) Year 2016-2017

Title of the Project: A Study on the ecosystem and biodiversity of Kopili area.

Outcome: A Total of 180 students consisting of 15 Assamese Major, 5 Economics Major, 10 Education Major, 13 English Major, 3 Philosophy major, 15 Political Science Major and 119 General course students of the B.A. 4th Semester carried out the field visit to nearby Kopili, Rani, under the guidance of college teachers. The students later submitted detailed reports highlighting ecosystem and biodiversity of the Kopili area along the side of river Kopili.

c) Year 2017-2018

Title of the Project: A case study on the dumping ground at Deepar Beel area and its impact on society and environment in the surrounding villages.

Outcome: A Total of 222 students consisting of 21 Assamese Major, 1 Economics Major, 8 Education Major, 6 English Major, 4 Hindi Major, 1 History Major, 3 Philosophy Major, 5 Political Science Major and 173 General course students of the B.A. 4th Semester carried out the field visit to nearby Deepar Beel (Lake) dumping ground under the guidance of teachers of different departments of the college. Later the students submitted detailed field study report highlighting environmental status, concerns of the lake after consulting the concerned teacher of the subject at the college.

d) Year 2018-2019

Title of the Project: Solid waste and its impact on environment: a study in Dharapur market area.

Outcome: A Total of 224 students consisting of 20 Assamese Major, 6 Economics Major, 12 Education Major, 3 English Major, 2 Hindi Major, 1 History Major, 1 Philosophy Major, 11 Political Science Major and 168 General course students of the B.A. 4th Semester carried out the field visit to nearby Dharapur market area under the guidance of teachers of the college. Later the students submitted detailed field study report based on their observation and findings.

e) Year 2019-20

Title of the Project: Rapid urbanization and its impact on the environment : a study in Dharapur area.

Outcome: A Total of 173 students consisting of 16 Assamese Major, 3 Economics Major, 11 Education Major, 4 English Major, 6 Hindi Major, 4 History Major, 2 Philosophy Major, 10 Political Science Major and 117 General course students of the B.A. 4th Semester carried out the field visit to nearby Dharapur market area under the guidance of teachers of the college. Later the students submitted detailed field study report based on their observation and findings.
